Story Webs

Dear Parents,

Welcome to 4th grade! As you know, the students are required to read two books over the summer and do a project on one of the books. **ALL** students are required to read Because of Winn Dixie by Kate DiCamillo. We will be doing activities, learning vocabulary, and taking tests on this novel. The students **DO NOT** do their project on Because of Winn Dixie.

Students are also required to read another novel this summer. The students have a choice between Frindle by Andrew Clements, There's a Boy in the Girl's Bathroom by Louis Sachar, and Tales of a Fourth Grade Nothing by Judy Blume. **The students need to pick one of these three books to read, and this is the novel the students need to use to do their project.**

The students will be making a story web for their project. The story web needs to be on a regular size poster board (22x28). The poster board can be any color except black. Each part of the web needs to be labeled with the correct information. The students should be as creative as they want with the poster board. The students need his/her name, date, and class code on the back of the poster board. The project will be worth a total of 85 points. Please do not use glitter on the poster board, as it makes a mess. Use your imagination to decorate your poster! Have fun! Below you will find the rubric that will be used to grade the project and an example story web. Have a great summer!

Rubric for Summer Reading Project

Name, date, and class code on back of poster – **5 points**

7 parts for story web – **14 points (2 points per part)**

Each part of story web labeled – **14 points (2 points per part)**

Spelling/Grammar – **10 points**

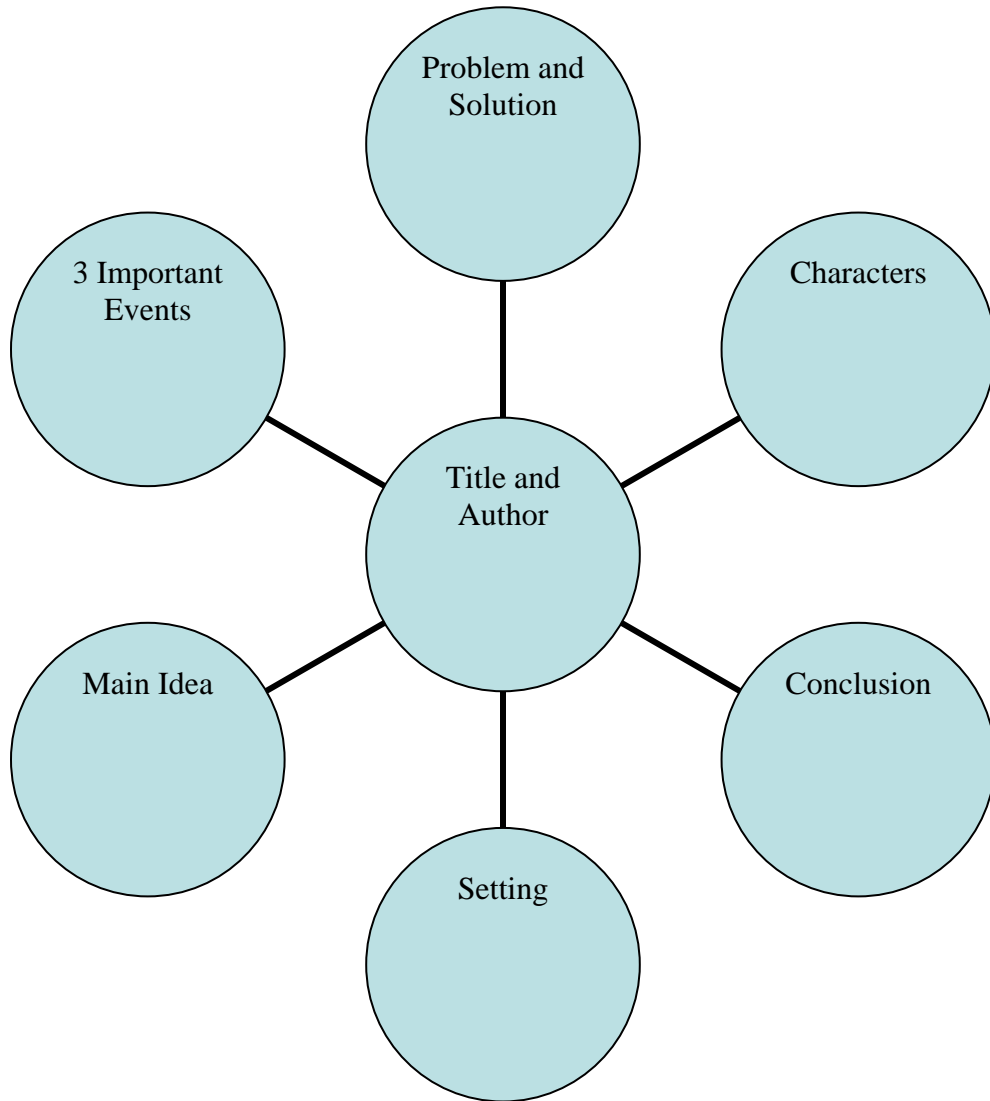
Accuracy of Information – **35 points (5 points per part)**

Poster Decorated Neatly – **7 points**

Total – **85 points**

*****Reminder: DO NOT do your project on Because of Winn Dixie. DO your project on ONE of the following: Frindle, There's a Boy in the Girl's Bathroom, or Tales of a Fourth Grade Nothing.**

*****The above web is a "sample" of a story web using the basic shape of a circle. Be creative and use your imagination for the shapes.**

(Examples Used Last Year for Charlie and the Chocolate Factory: golden ticket, candy wrappers, glass elevator, lollipops, blueberries, etc.)
